### GA Solar Lauds Improved Compensation for Rooftop Solar

The Georgia Solar Energy Association applauds a new compensation program for Georgia Power customers that install their own solar. This program could improve the ROI for onsite solar investments.

The program, available to 5,000 Georgia Power solar customers or 32Mw, whichever comes first, will credit them at a higher rate for the energy they feed to the grid.

Solar jobs increased in 31 states in 2019. Florida led the nation for the number of jobs added, followed by Georgia.

The census highlights the Southeast as "one of the hot spots for American solar growth," and eight of the region's 13 states experienced solar job growth in 2019. After Georgia, the largest increase in jobs in <u>SELC's six states</u> went to Virginia and South Carolina. The impact of the coronavirus on these numbers remains to be seen.



### More solar was installed than any other electricity source in 2019



Solar accounted for 40% of all new electric generating capacity in the United States in 2019, its highest share ever and more than any other source of electricity, with 13.3 GW installed.

Despite policy challenges and a second year of the Section 201 tariffs, the U.S. solar market grew by 23% from 2018, according to the <u>U.S. Solar Market Insight 2019 Year in Review report</u>, released by the Solar Energy Industries Association (<u>SEIA</u>) and <u>Wood Mackenzie</u>.
